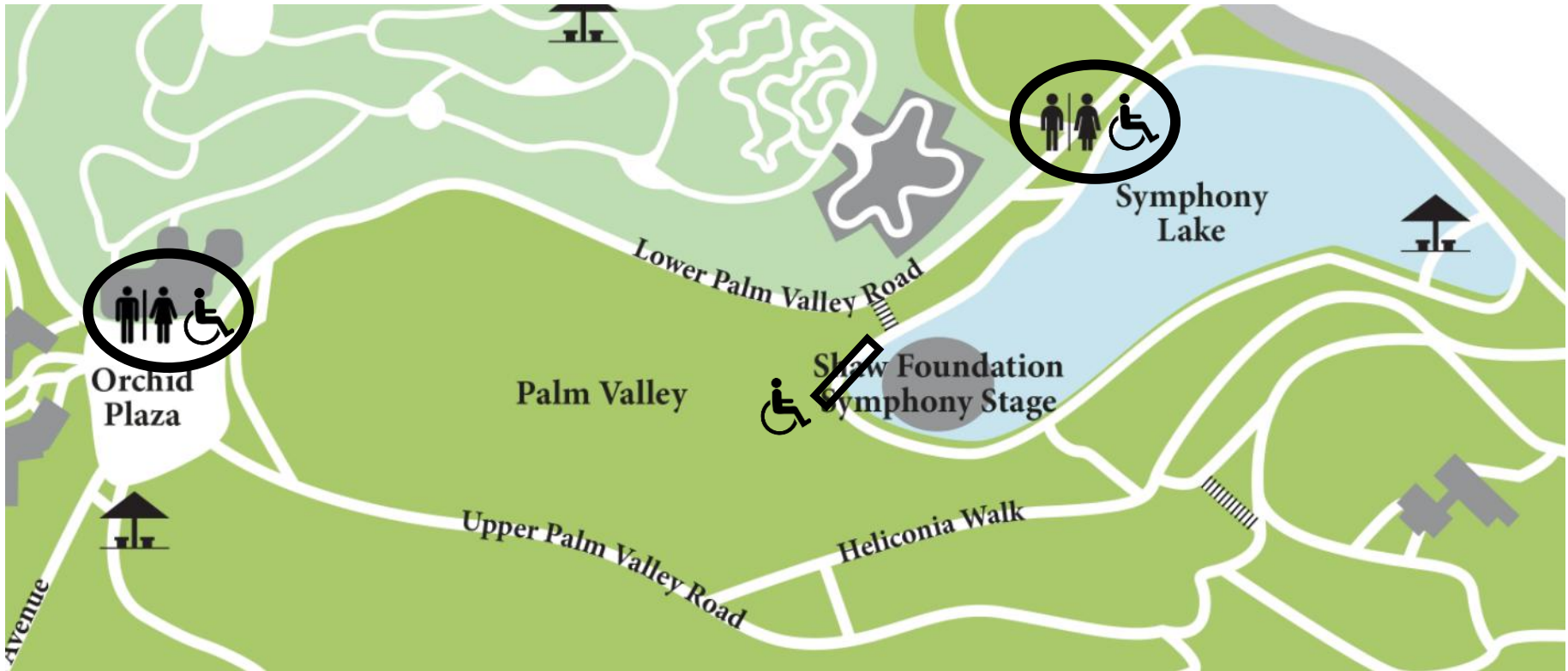

(Nassim Gate)

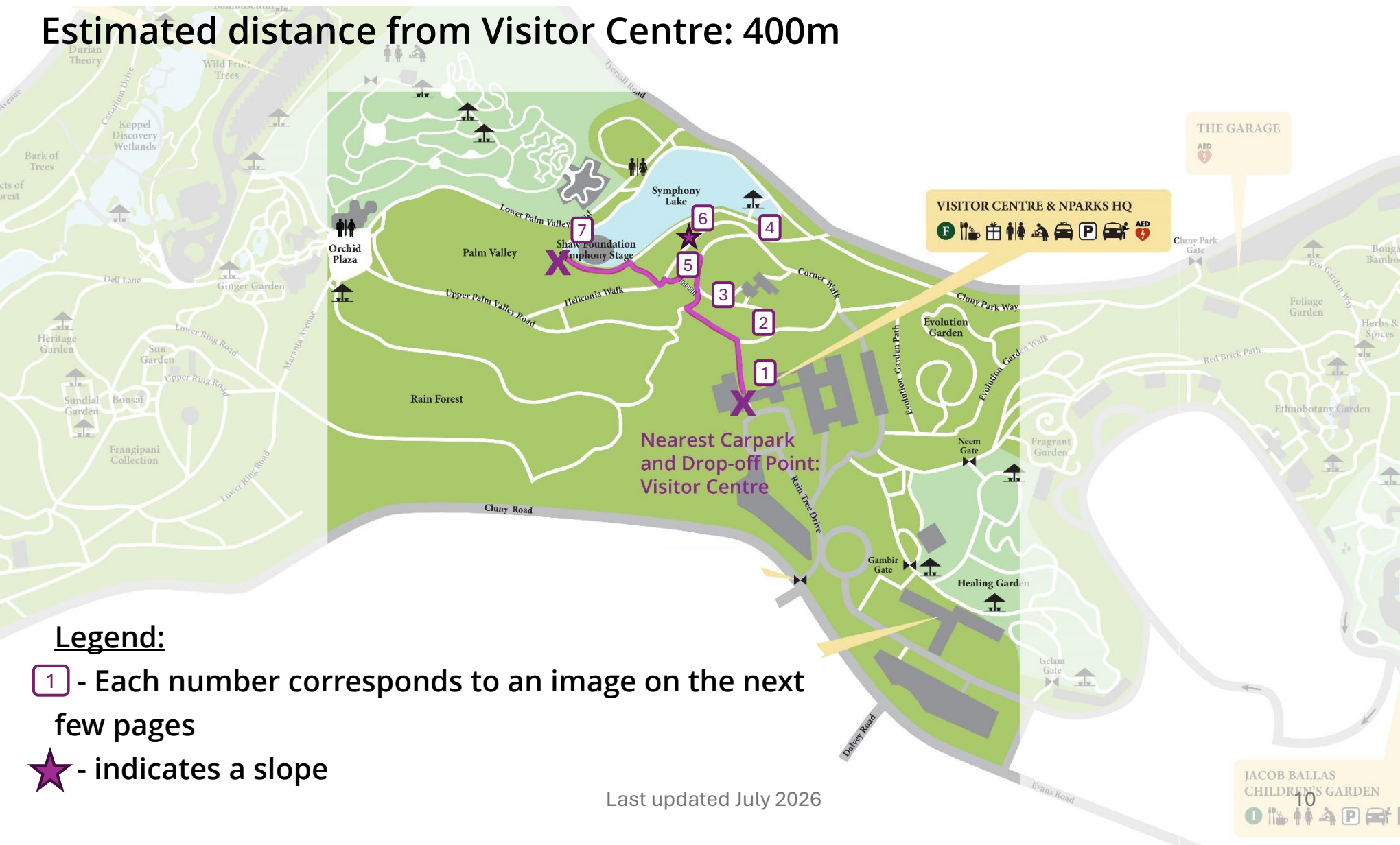


Directions from Visitor Centre & NParks HQ, Carpark and Drop-off Point (Nassim Gate)

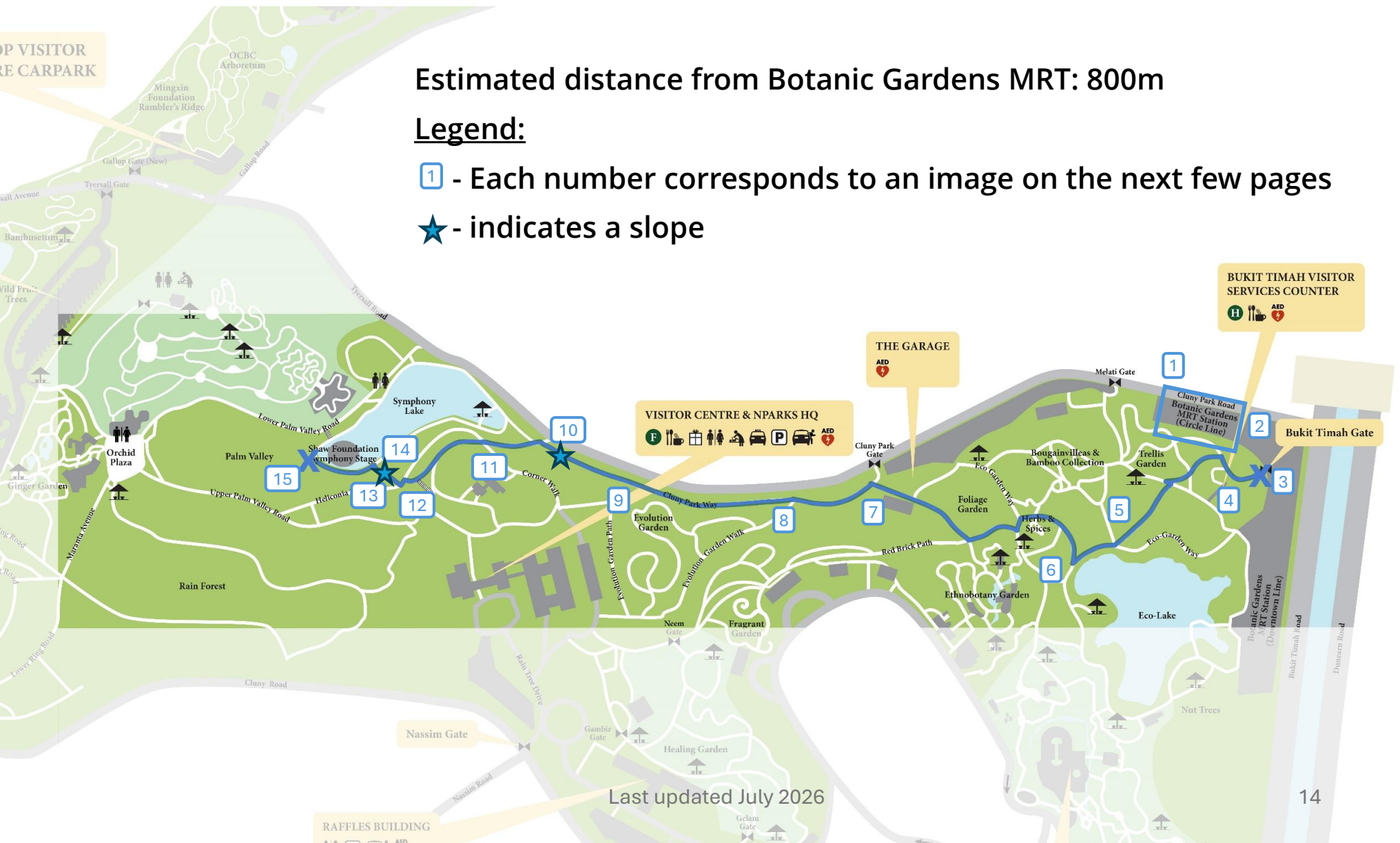

4. Continue past Visitor Services

6. Turn right at the fork and go straight



7. Turn left onto Cluny Park Way



8. Turn right at the signage

12. Go down the striped slope on the right



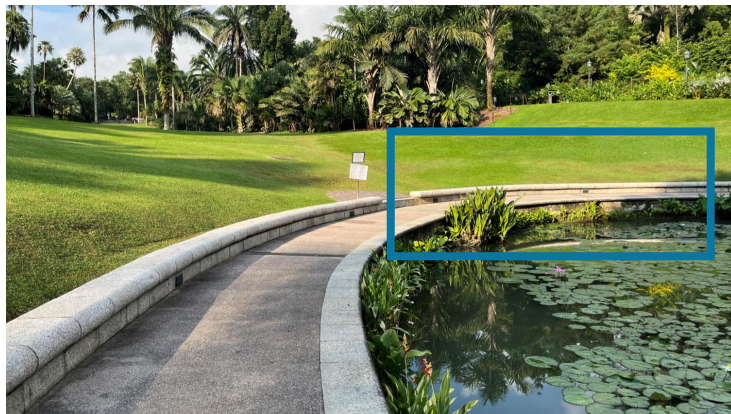

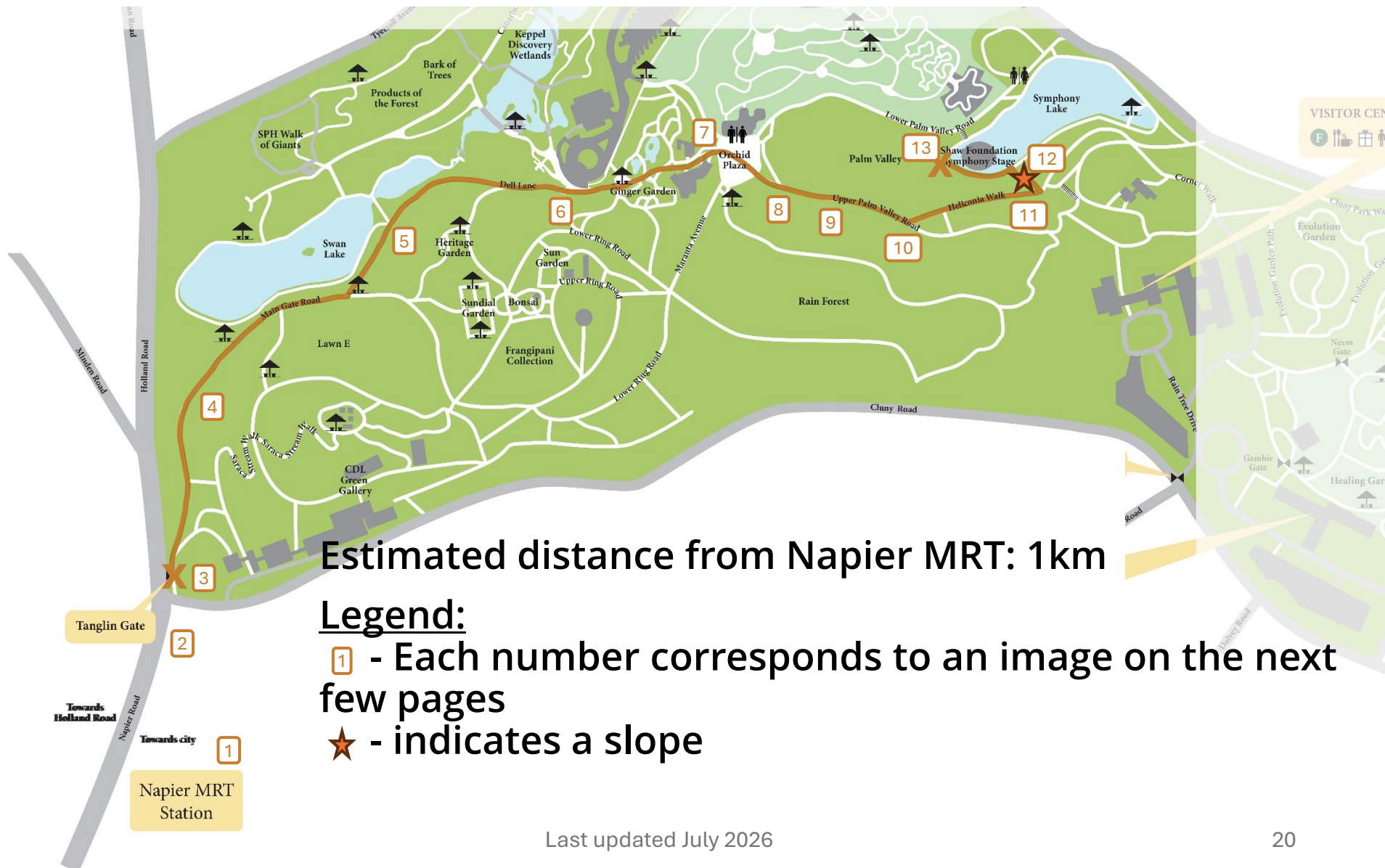

7. Continue towards Orchid Plaza



8. Head onto Upper Palm Valley Road

11. Continue down the path



12. Turn left at the end of the path

Frequently Asked Questions:

Q: Am I able to reserve a spot in the reserved area?

A: No, limited free-seating space is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Q: Who is this area reserved for?

A: It is reserved for wheelchair-users or people with physical disabilities, and one caregiver.

Q: How many people can the space accommodate?

A: Approximately 10 wheelchair-users and their caregivers.
