




Map of the stage area with reserved area marked with 'ఉ'. The nearest Accessible Toilets are circled.








# Directions from Napier MRT (Tanglin Gate)

1. Exit Napier MRT via Exit 1



3. Enter via Tanglin Gate and turn left



2. Cross the road



4. Go down Main Gate Road, past Swan Lake



5. Keep going straight



7. Continue towards Orchid Plaza



6. Go past the Learning Forest Drop-off Point



8. Head onto Upper Palm Valley Road



9. Continue along Palm Valley



11. Continue down the path



\* There are steep slopes along this route. Wheelchair users may require assistance. 10. Turn left onto the striped path



12. Turn left



13. You have reached the reserved area



### **Frequently Asked Questions:**

- **Q:** Am I able to reserve a spot in the reserved area?
- A: No, limited free-seating space is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

#### Q: Who is this area reserved for?

- A: It is reserved for wheelchair-users or people with physical disabilities, and one caregiver.
- **Q:** How many people can the space accommodate?
- A: Approximately 10 wheelchair-users and their caregivers.
